

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INCREASE AND RERATING.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 15 day of June A. D. 1897, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Enoch Anderson, aged 55 years, a resident of 631 Jasper Street, County of Baltimore and State of Maryland

who, being by me duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington D.C. Pension Agency at the rate of Six dollars per month, under Certificate No. 764869, by reason of disability from "Partial inability to earn a support by manual labor" (Here name the disability for which pension was granted.)

That his Military service was as follows: Private Co. "C" (Here state rank, company, and 7th Regt. U.S.C. Troops regiment, if in the Military Service; or vessel, if in the Navy.)

That he believes himself to be entitled to an increase of pension on account of his rating being too low and not adequate to the present extent of his disability.

That he also believes himself to be entitled to a rerating, at the rate originally allowed him, viz: \$ 10- per month, from 4 March 1895, when his pension originally allowed him was reduced to

\$ 6 per month that he is totally disabled for manual labor, and by reason of complete right inguinal hernia; Chronic rheumatism and Neuralgia of back, that said disabilities do and did exist on 4 March 1895, in a degree entitling him to full rating as prescribed by Law

That he hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo. W. F. Vernon 313 St Paul Street of Baltimore, Md.

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and directs fee of \$10. to be paid said attorney. That his Post Office address is 631 Jasper St. Baltimore Md.
