WE HEREBY CERTIFY that in compliance with the requirements of the law\* we have carefully examined this applicant, who claims that while in the service of the United States at or near a place named Deep Bottom Va, and while in line of duty, on or about the

day of \_\_\_\_\_, 1864, he incurred severe Ript Ly

and that in consequence thereof he is totally disabled for earning his subsistence by manual labor.  
 His pulse-rate is 78 per minute; his respiration 16; his temperature normal  
 his height is 5 feet and 7 1/2 inches; he weighs \_\_\_\_\_ pounds, and states that he is 38 years of age.

Here give the statement of the claimant fully, but as compactly as possible.

Touching the cause and degree of the disability for which he claims a pension, he makes the following statement: Alleges the wound pains him in walking and that he cannot straighten the right leg without pain - condition aggravated by greater change - at times he is lame -

Here give a full symptom picture of the case, embracing all the physical and rational signs, but confining it to the present condition of the claimant.

The examination reveals the following objective facts in support of his statements: Ball extent minor aspect of right thigh thigh at junction of middle and lower 3/4 - passed inward & upward and emerged on posterior aspect of thigh 2 1/2 inch higher than entrance - cicatrix of entrance 3/4 inch in diameter, adherent and indurated - he became lame after moderate amount of walking

Here give rating for each cause of disability, and state the aggregate.

From the existing condition and the history of this claimant, as stated by himself, it is, in our judgment, \_\_\_\_\_ probable that the disability was incurred in the service as he claims, and that it has not been aggravated or prolonged by vicious habits.
