 111 and his daughter Mrs Mitridge  
 112 for over forty years - and at  
 113 Wash D C I worked for Mrs  
 114 Leggett Judge (decd) of 1st  
 115 between 15th + 16th Sts, NW, all  
 116 the time I was in that city.

117 I understand the object of this  
 118 examination and my Privilege  
 119 and am unable to attend on same  
 120 as I am employed in University  
 121 Parkway at present - and do not  
 122 wish to be represented. I raise  
 123 notice of the examination at
