To the Adjutant General, U. S. Army.

Sir: I have the honor to return herewith the papers received from your office in pension claim No. *530 420*, with such information as is furnished by records filed in this Office, viz: that *William Wales*, *1st Co. 5th U.S.C. Inf.* was admitted to *Hampton G.H. Fort Monroe Va.* *Aug. 17, 64* with *G.S. Wound* right thigh received at *Malvern Hill Aug. 13, 64*, and transferred *Sept. 3, 64* to *N.Y. City*; that he was admitted to *DeCamp G.H. Davis's Island N.Y. Harbor* *Sept 5, 64* with *G.S. Wound* right leg, and returned to duty *Jan'y 4, 65* and that he was admitted to *Conval. Barracks Hosp.* *Fort Hood, Bedloe's Island N.Y.H.* *Jan'y 4, 65*, diagnosis not stated (no prescriptions on file) and returned to duty *Jan'y 19, 65*.

Records of wounded pertaining to the battle of *Deep Bottom Va.* *Aug. 13, 64* to *Aug. 31, 64* furnish no evidence in this case.
