Answer, She has not, she has lived in the same tenement with me ever since he went away,

Question, Did you ever know a James Cole, who lived on Little Vine Street,

Answer, I did not,

Question, Did you know a coloured man named James Cole, beside your said brother

Answer, I have heard that there was another James Cole living some where in Baltimore, but I have never met him, dont know what part of Baltimore he lives in,

Question, Do you know a man named James Johnson, who was a soldier in Co. A 30 U.S. Col. Troops,

Answer, I know James Anderson, who used to be called Jim Johnson and who was in said Co, he lives in Little Tyeon Street, went to see him last night but was not admitted, on account of severe illness of said Anderson,

Question, Do you know any person who knows the fact of the death of your said brother, beside William Foot, Asbury Haunon, and James Anderson,

Answer, I do not,
