(Clint) also with James Ezekiel Cole, now living at Frederick the affiant hath heard, Affiant was mustered out at Roanoke Island on the 10 day of December 1863 at same time as James Ezekiel Cole, but that several months prior to this, James Cole with whom he was also intimately acquainted, died on Belle Plains of a Congestive Chills from exposure near Marine Hospital having been treated by Regt Surgeon Jackson at field hospital & was buried, his death was reported on the next day,

Deposition B, pages 32 & 33 Asbury Hanson, swears before me that he was a soldier in Co "A" 30 Col Troop, enlisted at Eastern Md Nov 9 1863, and served until mustered out, knew two men in said Co named Cole, James & Ezekiel, James Cole joined as a recruit in Virginia near Petersburg, cant remember the date, James was a tall, brown skinned man, about middle age, thinks he was six foot tall, About August 1864 a detachment was sent from Bowling Green to Belle Plains near Railroad, deponent was sergeant with the detachment and
