Exhibit C, page 20 Is a copy of marriage certificate filed in the bounty claim, showing that Claimant and Soldier were married on the 29 day of December 1855 by William Mahan a Local Preacher of the M. E. Church,

Upon enquiry I learn that William Mahan was a Local Preacher, living near Owing Mills for a number of years before and after the late war, he has been dead several years, did not learn date of his death, the marriage seemed to be satisfactorily established,

Exhibit E, pages 22 & 24 Claimant declares before me as to her marriage same as in Orig declaration, Describes Soldier as about her own age (Now about 52 years) light brown complexion, black hair and brownish eyes, and six feet tall
