There is also required the testimony of at least two credible persons who have known claimant and soldier from the time each became of marriageable age, showing whether either had been previously married; and the testimony of credible persons, having personal knowledge showing whether claimant and soldier were ever divorced, and whether they lived together as husband and wife up to the date of the soldier's death.

Witnesses should state their ages, post-office addresses and means of knowledge of the facts to which they testify.

Do not fail to inscribe upon each piece of evidence the soldier's name and his service and the number of your claim.
