SIR:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your request of June 2^d, 1879, for certain information for use in the consideration of application for Pension, No. 268,749, and to return it herewith, with the following information from the records of this office:

It appears from the Rolls of U. S. Colored Troops on file in this office that James Jones was enrolled on the 11th day of Aug^t, 1863, at Baltimore City, in Co. "H", 4th Regiment of U. S. Colored 2^d, to serve 3 years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Priv, on the 11th day of Aug^t, 1863, at Baltimore, Md, in Co. "H", 4th Regiment of U. S. Colored 2^d, to serve 3 years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. "H" of that Regiment for the months of from Organization to April 30th, 1864, he is reported present for duty. from April 30th to Oct 31st /64, "Absent sick. Wounded in action before Petersburg, Va., June 15th 1864." from Oct 31st /64, to Febr^y 28th /65, "Absent sick." March & April, present - with remark - "Absent sick." May & June, present for duty; from June 30th to Oct 31st /65, Absent. "Detached service as Brig teamster." Nov & Dec, present for duty. Jan^y & Febr^y /66. Absent. "Detached service as teamster at Washington, D.C. S. O. no 23 H. O. S. 4th U. S. C. D. Febr^y 11th /66. He was mustered out of service with les, May 14th 1866, at Washington, D.C. Co or Regt records do not locate wound.
