

State of Maryland, Baltimore City Court:-

In invalid pension claim
No. 566,786, of Jeremiah Howard,
late of Co. "G" 19th S. I. T., William H.
Anthony late of Co. "F" 19th S. I. T., having
been sworn as a witness made oath and de-
posed as follows:-

I knew claimant before the
War; ~~enlisted from the same law~~; and although we
were in different companies, ~~we~~ were con-
stantly together, and cooked and worked to-
gether. While in Virginia, I remember some trouble
he had with his throat and breathing - His command
went to Texas. Shortly after I went to Texas and
on arriving there, I found him suffering from
severe throat or lung or chest trouble which
seriously interfered with his breathing. This
was some 10 to 12 months after our en-
listment. While in the army he was so
sick at times he could not work and the trouble
grew worse.

We were both discharged the same
day and came to Baltimore together, and
have both lived here to the present - I
have seen him almost every week
since we came home and I
know from seeing him, hear-
ing him cough, and his slow
