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DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION

Act of June 27, 1890. AS AMENDED BY ACT OF MAY 9th, 1900.

Note.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of clerk of court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

STATE OF MARYLAND, CITY OF BALTIMORE, ss:

On this 19 day of May in year one thousand nine hundred and two, personally appeared before me, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE within and for the City and State aforesaid William Murray aged 62 years, a resident of the City of BALTIMORE, State of MARYLAND, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical William Murray, who was ENROLLED on day of 18, in U. S. Navy R. S. (Here state rank, company, and regiment if in the Army; vessel, if in the Navy). Alleghany in the service of the United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at on the day of 18

That he is wholly unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of affection (Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled) of right wrist rendering hand almost useless, rheumatism, affection of kidneys & back asthma disease of eyes & debility & affection of heart

claims each disability as material and that he should be given an aggregate rating under Act, May 9th, 1900.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has applied for pension under application No. That he is was a pensioner under Certificate No. 11716 but was dropped asks restoration (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given) If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made).

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That he make this declaration for the purpose of being on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

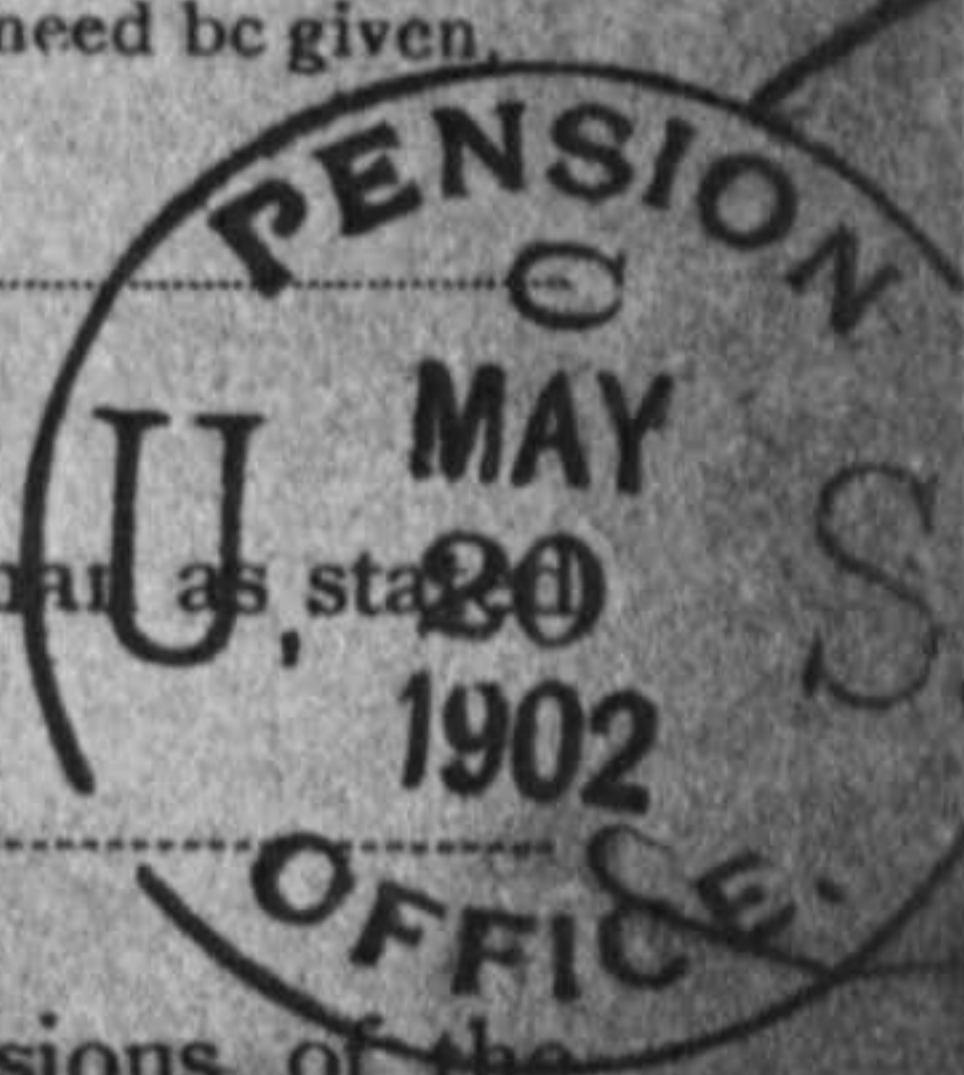
