

## Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record, or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of MD, County of Baltimore, ss:ON THIS 18<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty one personally appeared before me a Dpty Clerk of the Superior a Courtof Record within and for the County and State aforesaid William Murrayaged 48 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identicalWilliam Murray who was <sup>transferred</sup> ENROLLED as a Landman on the \_\_\_\_\_ day ofApril, 1864, in Company Reserving Alleganycommanded by Capt Lamer and was honorably DISCHARGED at\_\_\_\_\_ on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of August, 1865; That hispersonal description is as follows: Age 21 years; height 5 feet 4 inches; complexion mulattohair black; eyes grey. That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in theservice and in the line of duty at Baltimore Harbor in the State of MDon or about the Winter of 1864, 18 while cutting ice

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,
