McKenny (who is now dead) attended him &
that Dr Bull (also dead) also attended him for Rhe-
umatism. I know that he frequently had to
quit work on account of said disease although
his duties as coachman were light. He finally
had to quit work on account of his disease as Mr
Taylor kept him long after he could serve him.
Since then I have continued intimately acquainted
with him & know that during each & every year
since his discharge he has been entirely disabled
for hard labor & for manual labor fully one half his time
