I have pains in my joints, worse in damp weather. Have pain in left chest. Had a sore on my penis three years ago but had rheumatism long before that.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, *90*; respiration, *20*; temperature, *norm*; height, *5* feet *8* inches; weight, *160* pounds; age, *49* years. *The joints are dry & crepitant but not swollen. The shoulders are especially dry. Muscles tendons normal. Area of cardiac dulness enlarged. Apex beat lowered one inch. Slight bruit at apex with first sound. We think he has true rheumatism. Rate 8/18. Has a scar on frenum. Two deep scars in left groin. There is a line of scars beginning at episternal notch & running along clavicle to middle of neck behind. Scar over submaxillary glands. Throat red, roughened & injected but we find no loss of tissue. Skin clear. Scalp normal. Hair abundant. Eyes normal. Ling & feet bones normal. Has had syphilis but we think his rheumatism is independent of it. Is now stout & well nourished.*
