Rheumatism came many years ago while in service. I think heart disease supervened 12 or 15 years ago - after having rheumatism has been in bed with inflammatory rheumatism.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, *78*
respiration, *20*, temperature, *98*; height, *5* feet *7* inches; weight, *148*
pounds; age, *57* years.

Rheumatism: At present all joints and muscles are normal in size and action - he uses all his limbs freely and stoops over and assumes erect position easily - we do not find any rheumatism at present - there is no symptoms at present of any heart complication - that organ is normal in size and action - body well nourished - no cyanosis we do not at this examination find pensionable disability from rheumatism or heart disease.

[Not in red order] Disease of chest: - There is a constant spasmodic cough with increased respiration and dyspnea - his expansion at present is only 2 inches - large crepitation is heard over left anterior surface - a well defined moist rale is heard over lower part of right lung - not sufficient to rate.

Fail to sustain previous rating. No other disability found no other alleged.
