I have rheumatism and disease of heart. I have bad eyesight and weak back. I have asthma and kidney trouble

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 22; temperature, 98; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 145 pounds; age, 56 years. Gen physical condition good

Rheumatism - There is a rheumatic condition of both shoulder joints without atrophy or swelling of muscles or enlargement of the joints. There is no crepitation nor impaired motion. There is also rheumatic soreness over the lumbar muscles without atrophy or swelling of muscles. There is slight stiffness upon stooping and rising.

The actual or probable origin of every existing disability must be fully set forth. Whenever a disability is shown, or is believed to be due to or aggravated by vicious habits the opinion of the board must be stated. When not due to such habits this fact must be stated.

disease of heart - The heart is normal. disease of Eyes - There is conjunctivitis of both lower lids - Pupils are of average normal size and respond readily to light + shade. cornea transparent - Vision - Both eyes $\frac{2+}{40}$ - right eye $\frac{2+}{40}$ - left eye $\frac{2+}{40}$. Weak Back - due to rheumatism as described above.

Asthma - There are no objective symptoms of asthma. The lungs are normal. disease of kidneys - Urinary analysis reveals a normal condition of the kidneys.
