suffers with muscular rheumatism. He has no organic di-

vicious habits.We find that the aggregate permanent disability for earning
a support by manual labor is due to Age and Muscular Rheu-
matism, not due to vicious habits, and warrants a rating

strongest rea-
sons must be
given therefor.
