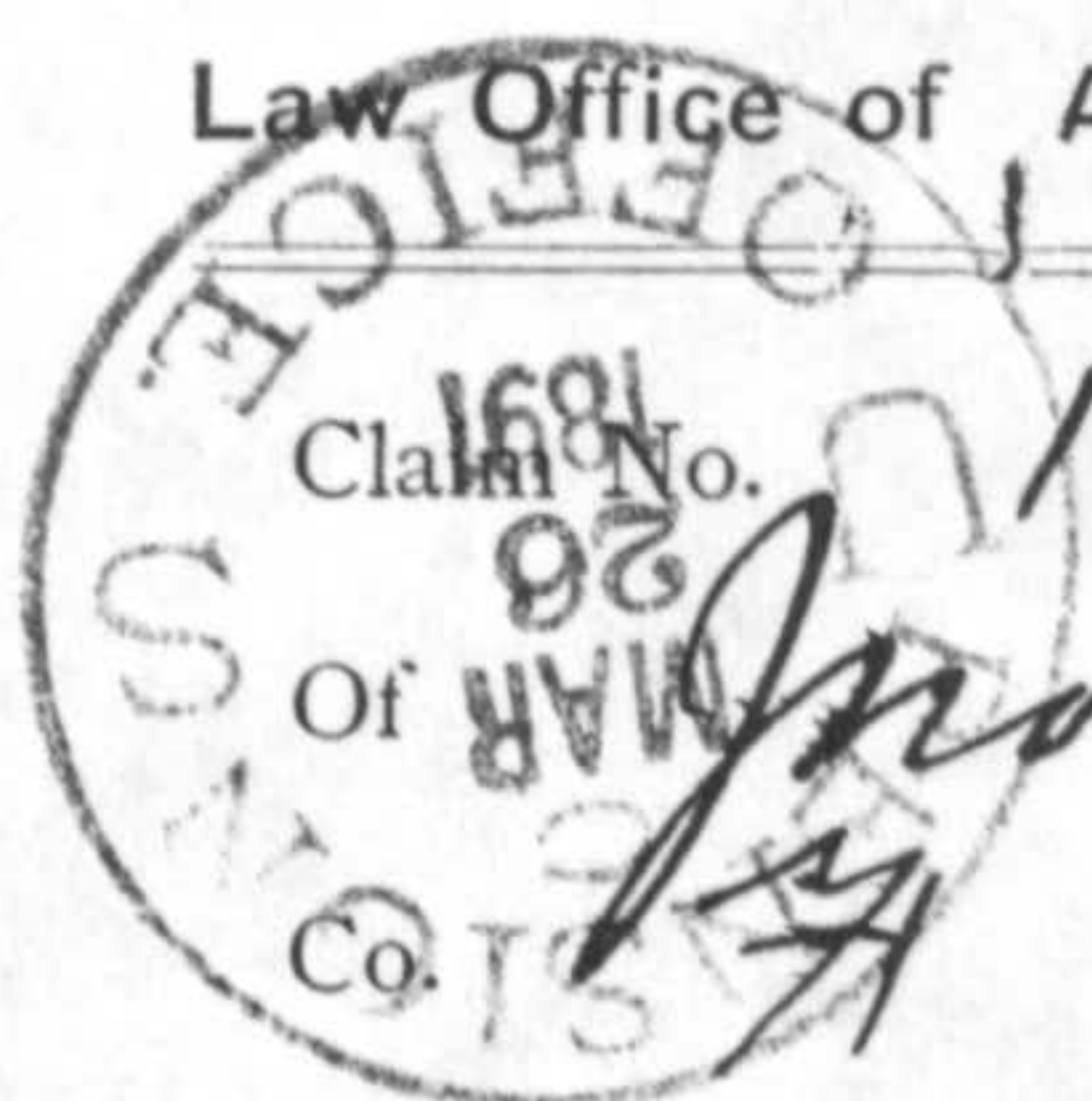

I positively know that at Petersburg July 1864 incurred G.S. wound to the left hand on or about the 18th of June 1865, the claimant in this case was at

in Texas as along in 1865 & 1866 & this document [Here state—received wound or injury, or contracted disease, giving particulars.] incurred rheumatism, deafness, weak back & fil in the service & line of duty

I know these facts from my personal intimacy with him at the time of the occurrence of the said disabilities and know from personal observation of his symptoms that he suffered from same during rest of the time we were together."
