To the Honorable, the Secretary of the Interior:

The appeal of A. Parlett Lloyd respectfully represents ^{my} sets forth.
1st That on the 7th of March 1907 an increase of pension was allowed the claimant above named under Act of June 27 1890 at \$12 month from 2 Feb 1907 ending 11 February 1907 by reason of allowance at equal rate under Act of February 6 1907."

2nd That the object of issuing these two certificates to the same man on the same day ^{my} at the same rate appears to have been to reduce the fee of the attorney from \$2 to 67 cents for prosecuting the claim for increase of pension. Your petitioner can conceive of no other possible object as the rate to the pensioner was the same in either event
