In response to your recent inquiry concerning the pension claim, No. 641,969, of Louisa Barnes, of No. 1744 Mulford Street, Camden, New Jersey, widow of Allen Barnes, late of Co. F, 19th U. S. Colored Vol. Inf., I have the honor to advise you that her claim for pension was rejected on December 5, 1900, as she was duly advised.

On November 23, 1904, she filed some testimony with a view to re-opening said rejected claim, but after a careful consideration of same, it was not deemed sufficient to warrant any change of action, and she was so informed on January 27, 1905, through her attorney, H. B. Phillips, of Trenton, New Jersey.
