 named his entering the army that he the said
 Chambers was healthy and sound (I had ~~no opportunity~~
 I saw no more of him until his return from the
 army - and as soon as he returned I went to see
 him as an old friend, I found his hearing was
 bad & he complained of his head & the great pain
 he suffered - he also had an injury to his right
 wrist. My visit to him was only a few days after
 his return from the army when I found him in the con-
 dition I have stated. The time was about the 20 day of
 Jan'y in the year 1867. I have no interest in this
 claim only as far as friendship goes.
