

Supplemental Act of June 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

State of MARYLAND, City of Baltimore, ss:

On this 11 day of Oct, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

five, personally appeared before me,

a John Morsell within and for the County and State aforesaid,

aged 53 years, a resident of the

City of Baltimore, County of MARYLAND

State of MARYLAND, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is

the identical John Morsell, who was ENROLLED on the 20

day of Oct, 1863, in Co H 7 Ill T Reg

(Here state rank, company, and regiment in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the service of the

United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at

Baltimore Md, on the 1st day of Nov, 1866.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated

above (Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he is partially unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of (Here name the disease or

injuries from which disabled.) Injury to left foot, left arm, & testicles, rupture

incurred in service, affection of back & kidney

+ Rheumatism, aff of eyes & general disability That said disabilities are not due to his

vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That he has

applied for pension under application No. 482302. That he is a pensioner under Certificate No

(If a pensioner, the Certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS as prescribed by law. That
