The exact date of Rebecca Nicholson's death I do not know — but I do know that it was in the early twenties —

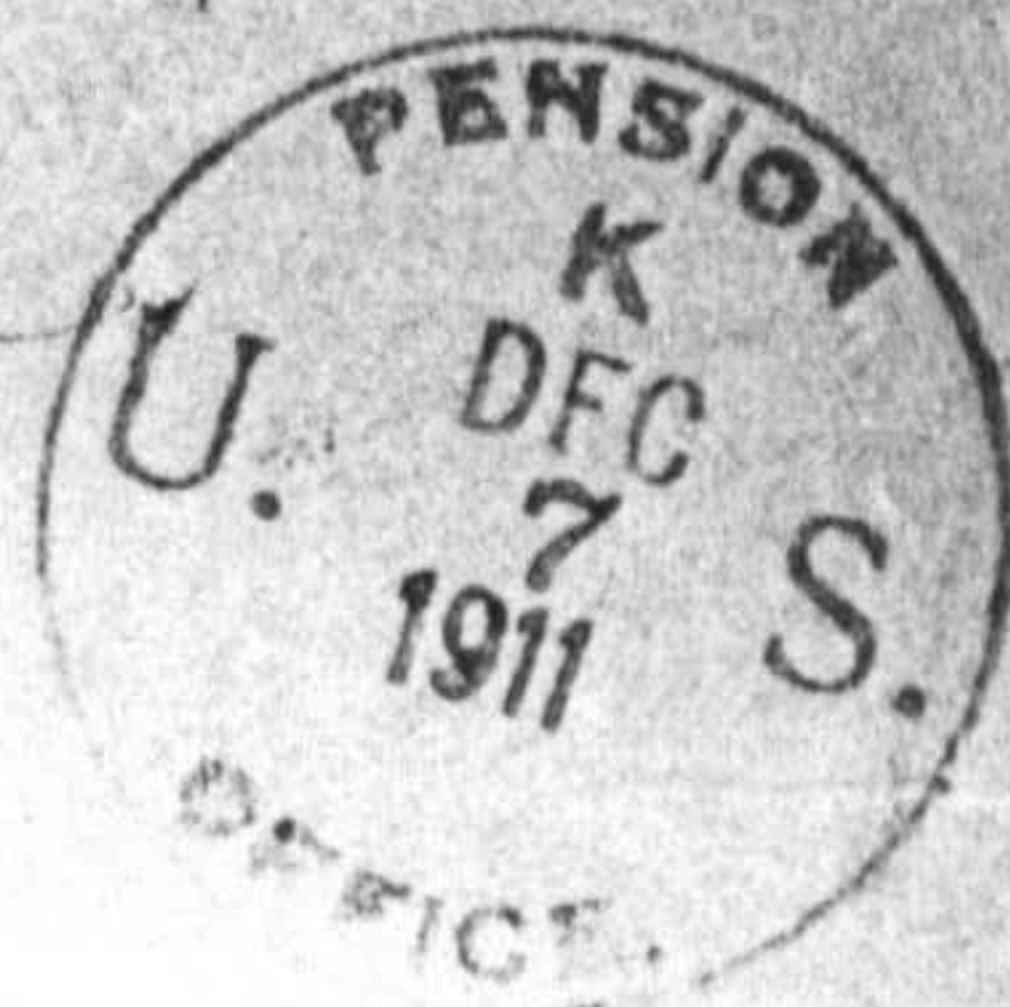
