In your claim, under Act March 3, 1899, for half the pension granted Benjamin Nicholson by Cert. 71,912, you are advised that the pensioner alleges that you left him July 5, 1894, and have since remained away from him; that his house has been, during all this time, open for you, but you have refused to return; that he always treated you as a kind, loving, true and dutiful husband should. Your statement as to the circumstances of separation and evidence in rebuttal of these allegations, must be clear and explicit.

You have been notified several times of these allegations and of the requirements indicated in the accompanying circular (3-080). If it is your intention to further prosecute the claim, the required evidence should be furnished without delay. Care
