"My name is Jeremiah Nicholson I am 51 years old, and I reside in Baltimore, Md. at No. 613 W. Hoffman Street.

I am a son of Benjamin Nicholson, the soldier, & have known him all my life. My mother's name was Rebecca Nicholson. Her name was Rebecca Pelton before she married my father, so I have always been told. She died in 1876. I was a boy then, & attended her funeral in Baltimore, Md. His second wife's name was Annie Wallace. He married her about 1879 and she died about 1 1/2 years later sometime in 1880. I saw her dead body. She died in Baltimore, Md. My father then married Eliza J. Gibson about 1882. They lived together for about 12 years when the claimant Eliza J. Gibson went away to work. She returned afterwards & was with him when he died on Jan. 1, 1911. They were never divorced. I have known the claimant ever since about 5 yrs prior to her marriage to my father. She has not remarried since his death.

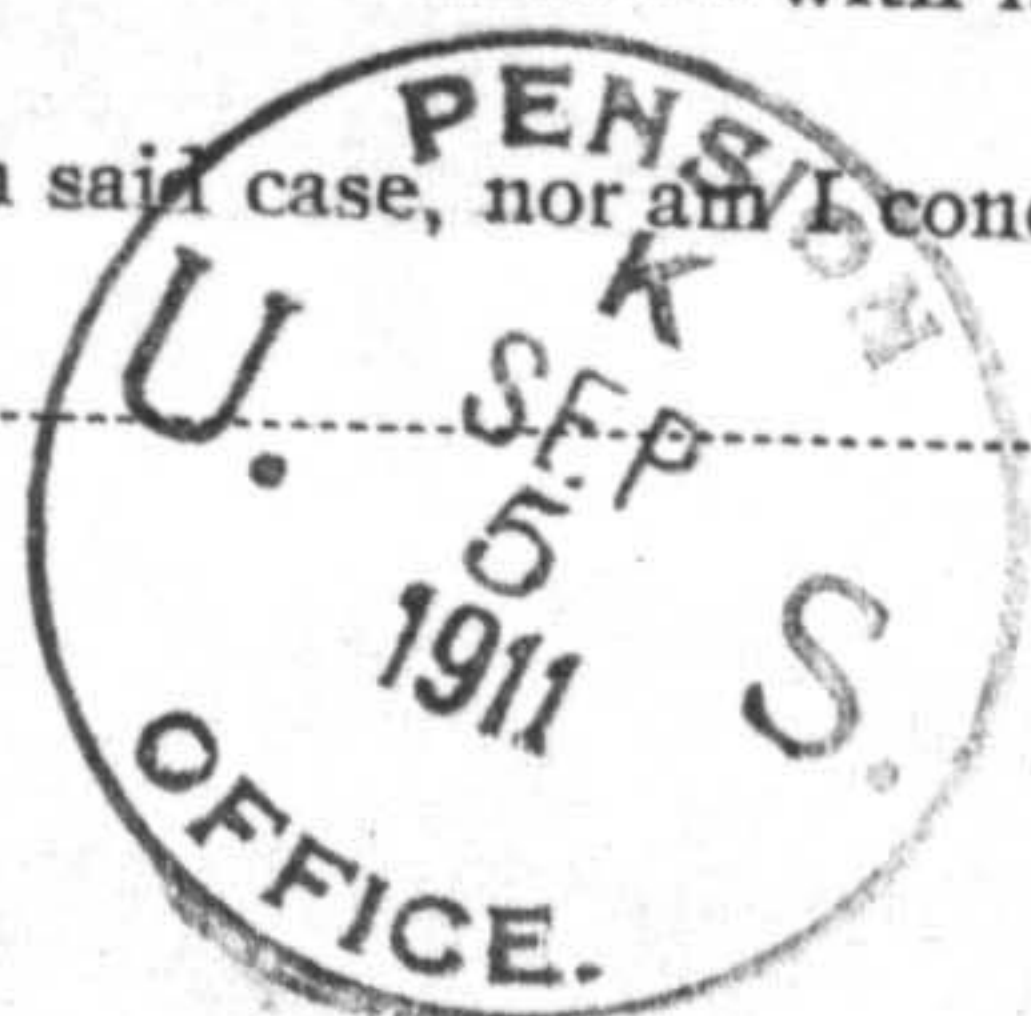
