To the Adjutant General, U. S. Army.

Sir: I have the honor to return herewith the papers received from your office in pension claim No. 528713, with such information as is furnished by records filed in this Office, viz: that John Wesley, Pvt. Co. E. 39th U.S.C.T. entered Norfolk, Va. Colored Troops City Point Va. Sept. 27, 64 with "bill fever" (prescriptions no evidence) disposition not shown; that John Wesley - Co. E. 39th Colored - was admitted to Hospital "Atlantic" Sept. 30, 64, diagnosis and disposition not stated (no prescriptions on file); that John Wesley, Pvt. Co. E. 39th U.S.C.T. entered Grant G.H. Willet's Point N.Y. Oct. 2, 64 from G.H. City Point, with Rheumatism (no prescriptions on file), furloughed Oct. 11, 64, re-admitted Oct. 22, 64 and returned to duty Nov. 15, 64; that he entered Hospital Barracks, Norfolk, Fort Wood, Bedloe's Island, N.Y. Harbor Nov. 15, 64 diagnosis not stated (no prescriptions on file) returned to duty Nov. 24, 64; that he was admitted to Flying Field Hospital 25th A.C. Richmond Va. Dec. 10, 64 with Bronchitis and returned to duty Dec. 14, 64 (no prescriptions on file); that he entered Point of Rocks Hospital, A. & J. Point of Rocks Va. Dec. 10, 64 with Rheumatism (no prescriptions on file covering period) and was transferred Feb. 12, 65 to that he entered G.H. Fort Monroe, Va. Feb. 13, 65 with Rheumatism (no prescriptions on file) and returned to duty March 13, 65. Such records as are on file bearing on this inquiry Sept. 12 to 27, 64 furnish no evidence in this case. - No medical records of the Regiment on file. - No record found of claimant's treatment for any disability other than those above indicated.
