and was treated in hospitals of which the names, location, and dates of treatment are as follows: Regimental Surgeons, and Hosp. at City Point Va; Fort Mifflin; Hospital Port York City; Bellows Island, Willets Point, N.Y. & Point of Rocks, Va. All between June 1864 and Nov 30, 1865.
