

Declaration for Invalid Pension.

Act of June 27, 1890.

NOTE.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of Clerk of Court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

State of John Wesley, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 4th day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety one

personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace

within and for the County and State aforesaid, John Wesley

aged 62 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore

County of Baltimore State of Maryland, who, being

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical John Wesley

who was ENROLLED on the 4th day of June, 1864, in C Co 39 US I Co I

and regiment, in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at June on the 4th day of June, 1865.

That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Rheumatism, Vertigo and neuralgia, disease of heart, bronchitis in his service, disease of eyes & piles, that he

dreams an aneurism at his diabetetic for which he is

he is pensioned, hard to increase that he now totally disabled for manual labor & cleaning

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That

he has applied for pension under application No. 509179 That he is a pensioner

under Certificate No. 509179 (If a pensioner, Certificate only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

A. Partitt Lloyd of Baltimore and Md

his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and he directs that the sum of ten dollars be paid to said attorney
