he suffered from same during rest of the time we were together."

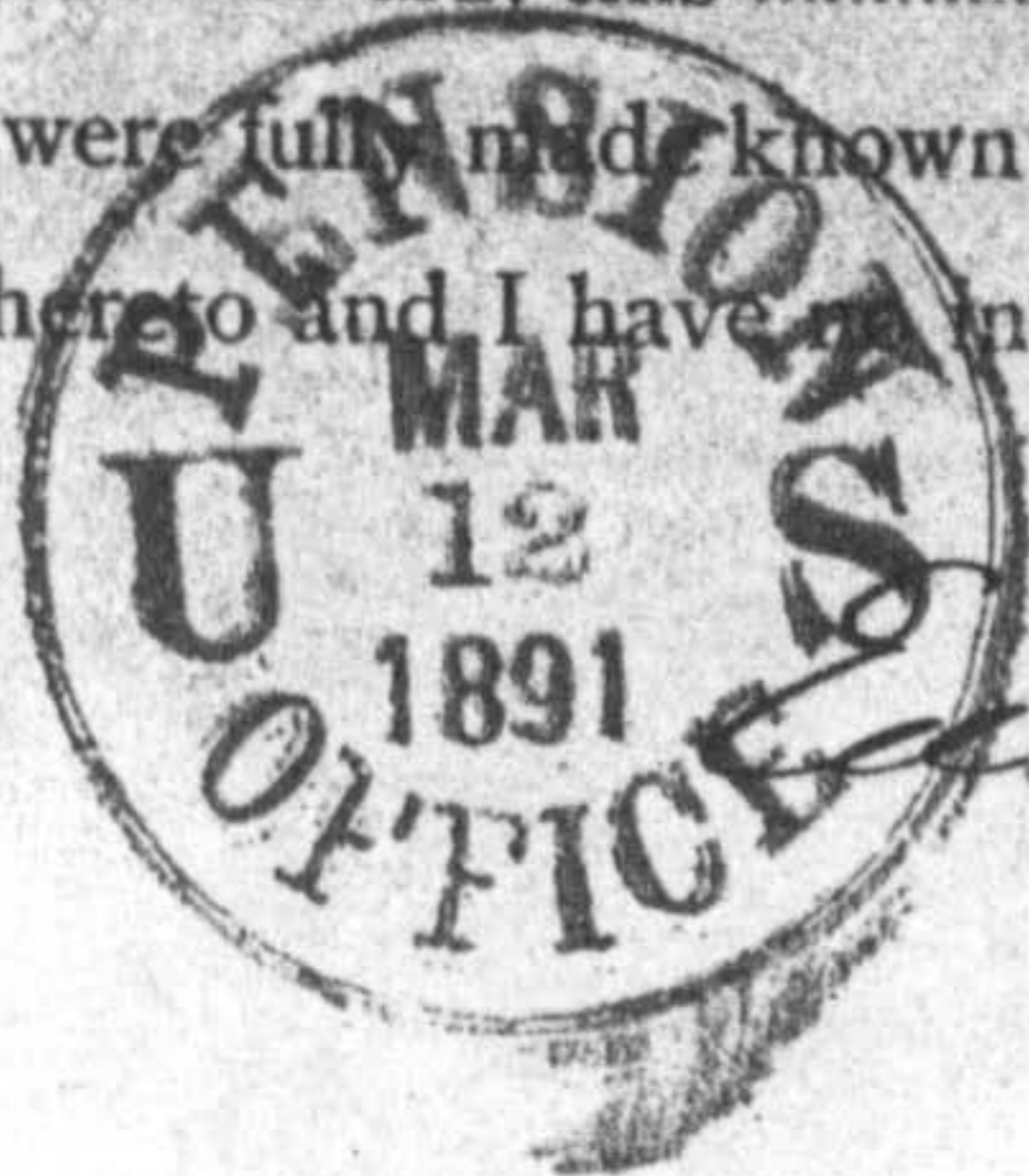
