

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

To be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in _____ State, city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or clerk of a court shall be necessary; but when no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall affix his official seal thereto, and shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, SS:

ON THIS 2^d day of January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace

within and for the County and State aforesaid Charles J. Brooks aged 52 years, a resident of the 1215 Shields Alley City of Baltimore State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law

declares that he is the identical Charles J. Brooks who was enrolled on the December day of 1863 in Co. A. 19th Regt Here state rank, company, and regiment in military service, U.S.C.T. or vessel, if in the Navy.

in the service of the United States in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days and was honorably discharged at Baltimore Md on the 15th day of January, 1867. That he is unable to earn a support

by manual labor by reason of bullet wound in right fore arm Here name the disease or injuries from which disabled.

Received on Picquet duty near Waldorf Va in 1864 and Chronic Rheumatism affecting all of his limbs. Both arms and leg

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character; that he has Not applied for pension under Certificate No. that he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.

That he has Not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo. W. Vernon of St. Paul Street City, of Baltimore

State of Maryland, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and to receive therefor a fee of ten dollars; that his post-office address is 1215 Shields Alley City of Baltimore, State of Maryland
