# DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 28 day of March, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and ten, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Charles Jefferson Brooks, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 64 years of age, and a resident of Baltimore City county of Baltimore, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore Md under the name of Charles Jefferson Brooks, on the 15th day of December, 1863, as a Private, in Company A 19th Regiment (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) United States Colored Volunteer Infantry in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Federal Hill, on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 18\_\_\_\_. That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.
