

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Queen Annes, ss:

On this 18 day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid,

Charles A. Wilson who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 69 yrs Oct-1914 years of age, and a resident of Bentsville, county of Queen Annes, State of Maryland;

and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore Maryland, under the name of Charles A. Wilson

on the 31 day of March, 1864, as a private, in 39th Regt U S Col, troops

(Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED

at Wilmington N.C., on the 4 day of December, 1865.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet inches; complexion, dark; color of eyes, black; color of hair, black; that his occupation was laborer on farm; that he was born October, 1842, at near Bentsville Maryland

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: only near and in Bentsville Maryland (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 576648. That he has applied for pension under original No.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of May 11, 1912.

That his post-office address is Bentsville, county of Queen Annes, State of Maryland.

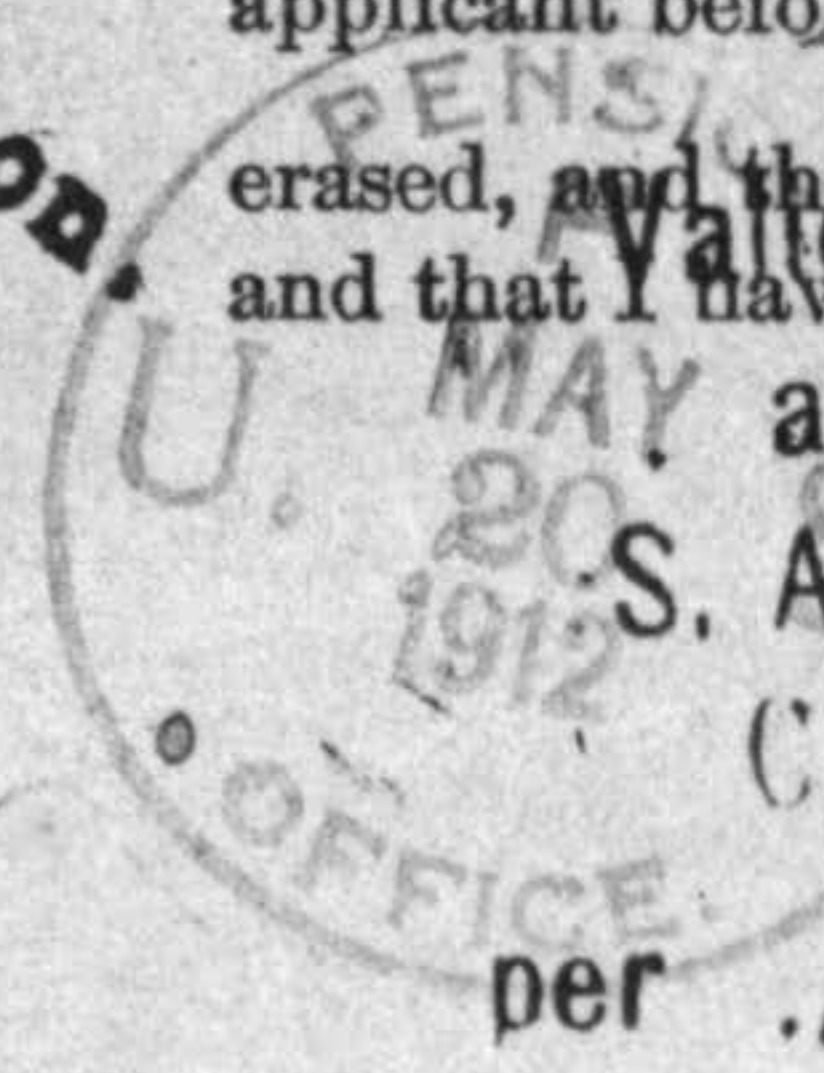
