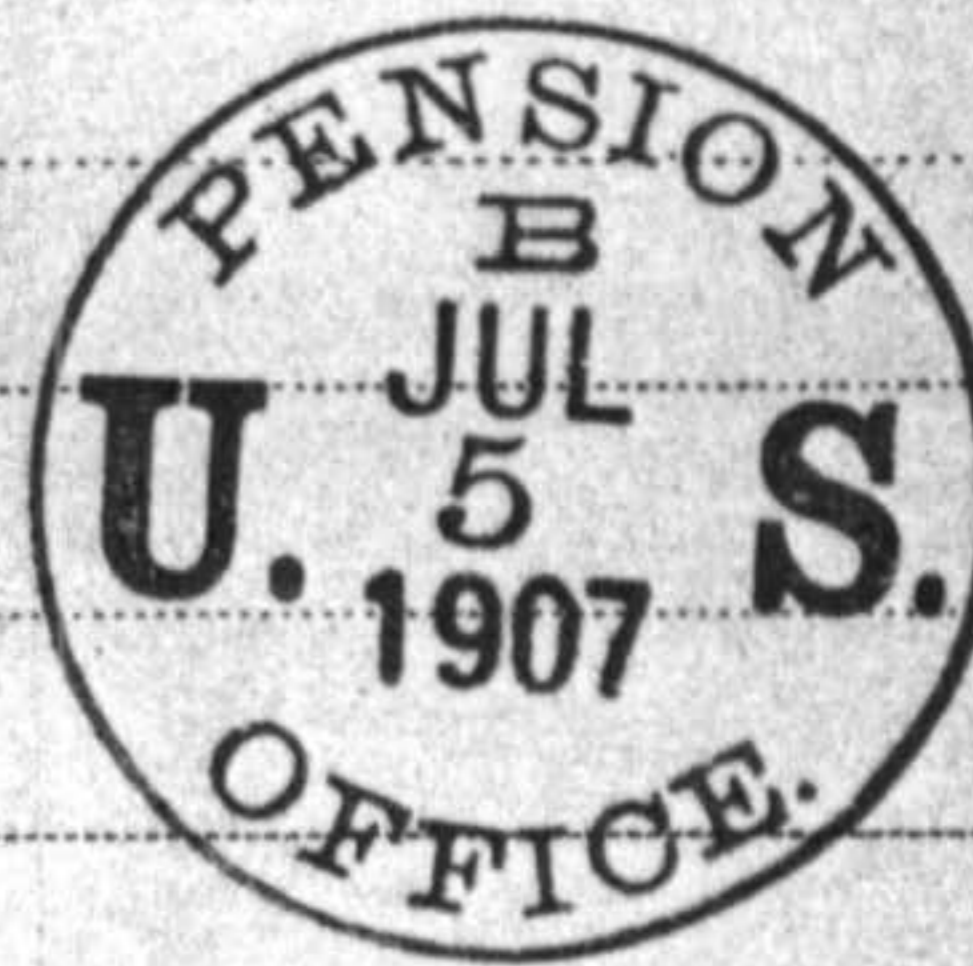
Claim No. 7563108 Of *Widow* *Edw. Co. C 39 Reg't. Md.*
