heard of one such case in which -  
the claimant was aware that she  
was a witness.

Howard the identifying witness  
convincing Smother's - in fact on  
the occasion of their going to the  
court - together - it was in his Howard's  
claim; that he knows nothing  
of further making a claim that  
day - and that he did not see  
anything any one to write his name  
in the application. He says it  
was Lloyd and not Rice that  
went along with them that day  
but there was a general resemblance  
between the two and  
the affidavit of identity convicts  
Smother's.

As claimant represents his  
old law claim he should be  
required to file a new one. He  
has undertaken to establish one  
under the old law.
