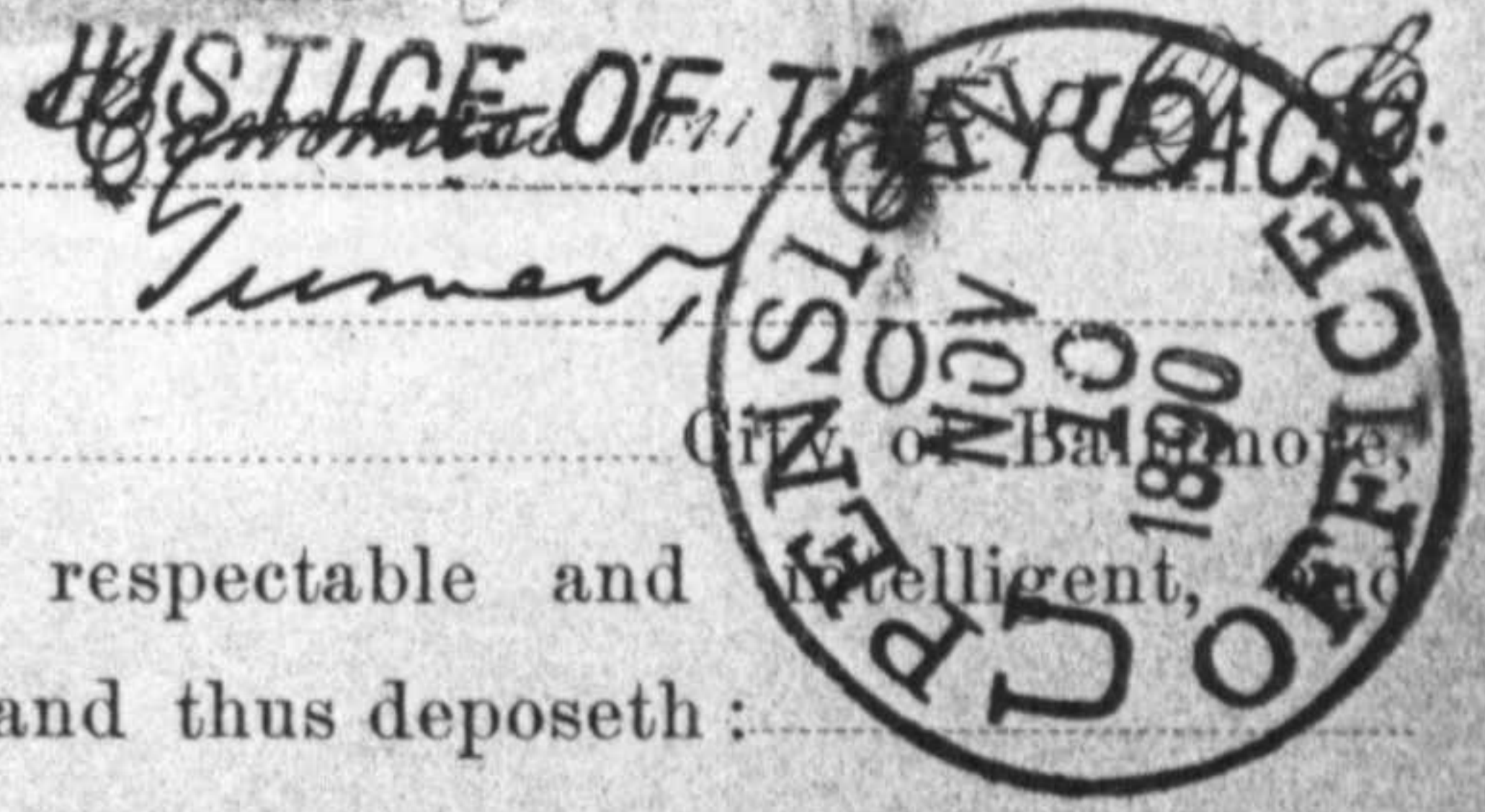


State of Maryland, City of Baltimore.

I remember that my comrade Edward [unclear] brother of my company, was employed in the spring of 1865 at Wilmington, D. C. I could not find on right side of body [unclear] address unable to make any great exertion or do any heavy work like lifting. I know to that at the same place later in the summer he began to grow deaf and it was with some difficulty that we could make him understand conversation.
