ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT.

Whereas I, Charles H. Brooks son of James S. Brooks late a Corporal in Company G, of the 9th Regiment of U.S.C. Volunteers, war of the Rebellion, having made application for pension under the laws of the United States:

Now this agreement witnesseth: That for and in consideration of services done and to be done in the premises, I hereby agree to allow my attorney,

H. S. BERLIN, of Washington, D. C.,

the fee of Twenty-Five Dollars, which shall include all amounts to be paid for any services in the furtherance of said claim; and said fee shall not be demanded by or payable to my said attorney, in whole or in part, except in case of the granting of my pension by the Commissioner of Pensions; and that the same shall be paid to him in accordance with the provisions of Sections 4768 and 4769 of the Revised Statutes, U. S.

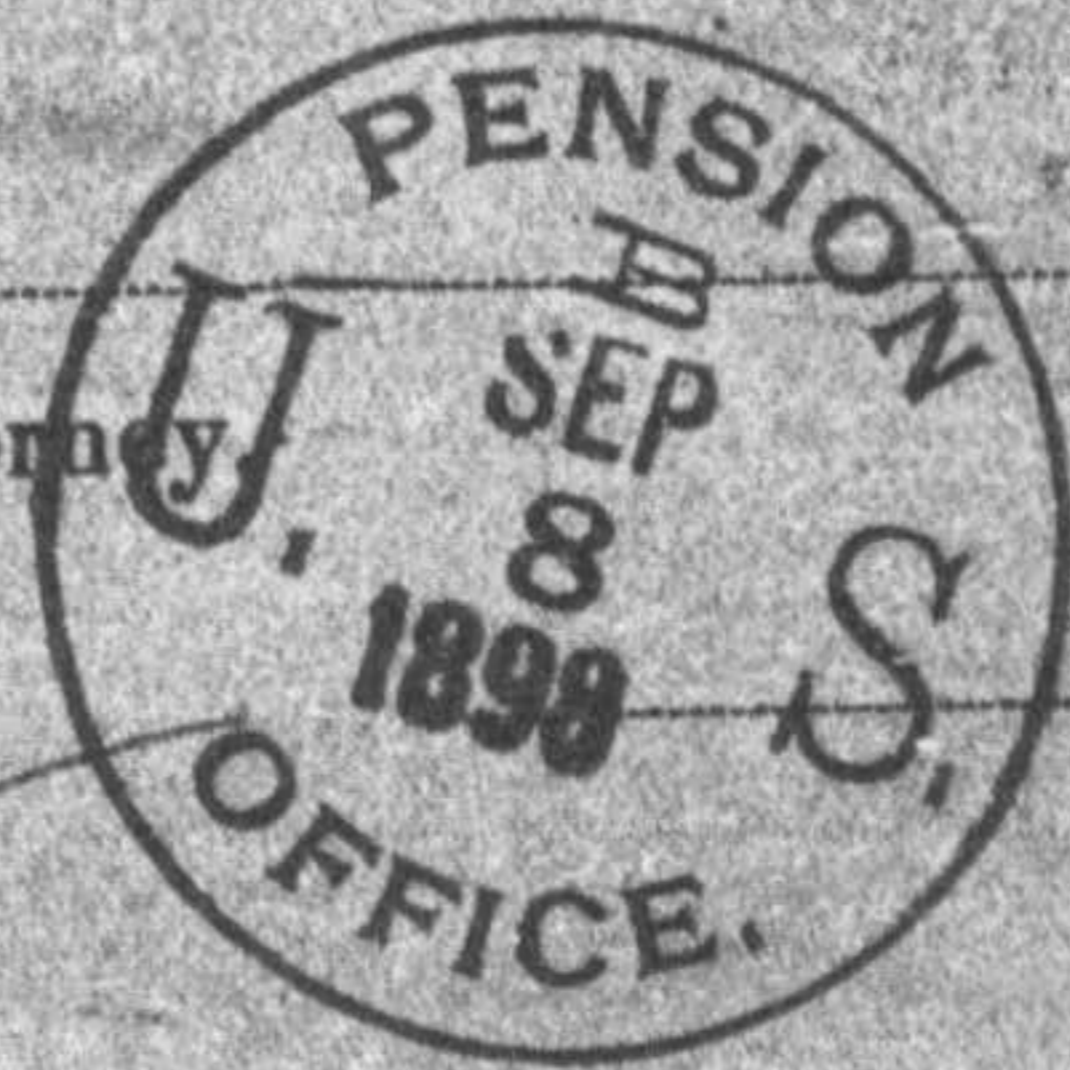
