On this day and date below written, personally appeared the affiant whose signature is hereto affixed and who being duly sworn according to law testified as follows:

"My age is 48 years, I reside in Baltimore, Md., at No. 920 Marner Street.

I served in Co G 17 Regt with the Soldier John Snowden and know that while in his service and line of duty he contracted a severe shelling sensation about his jaw, foot and gums while our troops were in Va near Chipping Horn or also in front of Petersburg about the summer of 1864. The complaint was paid attention of the face up to the time he was taken a prisoner at the charge of Fort Sumner about Sept 29 1864 I knew him intimately up to his death and know that the cause from which he died first originated in the jaw and he always claimed it up to his death

I have no interest in this claim.
