3. I furnish positive proof of disability; and I respectfully call attention to the evidence herewith and hitherto filed being:

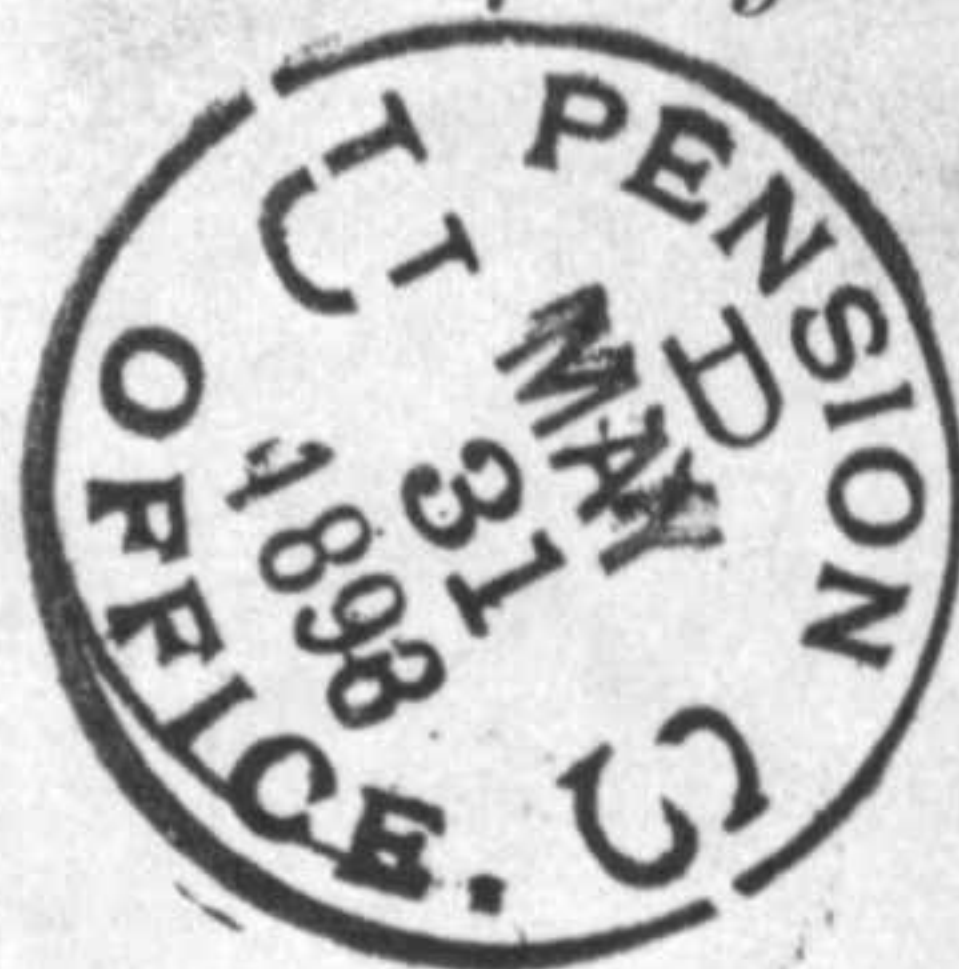
- (a) My sworn allegations as to **NEW** disabilities,
