

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

On this 11th day of July, A. D., one thousand nine hundred and thine, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Frances Jones, aged 56 years, a

(Insert name of applicant.) resident of 623 King Street, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of

Charles H. Jones, who enlisted under the name of Charles H. Jones, on the 27th day of September, A. D.

18 63, as a Captain in Company H, in the 7th Regiment of U. S. C. Troops Volunteers, and served at least ninety days in the late War

(Name of State, and whether Infantry, Cavalry or Artillery.) of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED 13th October 1866, and died July 2nd 1903. That he was not employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

(Date of Discharge.) (Date of death; cause need not be stated.) and did not serve prior to 27th Sept. 1863 that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he was never employed in the military or naval service of the United States after the day of October, 18 66. That she was married under the name of Frances Perkins to said Charles H. Jones, on the 17 day of June, A. D. 18 68, by Rev. Mr. Frisby at Chesterton, Md, there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that she had not been previously married; that her said husband had not been previously married. (4) no former marriage by claimant or deceased soldier

(If either had been previously married, so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.) That she has not remarried since the death of the said Charles H. Jones

(Name of soldier or sailor.) That she is without other means of support than her daily labor. That the names and dates of birth of all the children of the soldier, now living, and under sixteen years of age, are as follows:

no children, 18 under 16 years of age, born 18, born 18, born 18, born 18

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance. That no prior application for pension has been filed by herself or the soldier but was a pensioner under Cert. No. 559071

(If prior application has been filed, either by soldier or widow, so state, giving number assigned to it.) That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo. W. H. Vernon of 106 E. Saratoga St Baltimore Md her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, the fee to be TEN DOLLARS, payable as prescribed by law
