

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having custody of the Seal.

ON THIS 28th day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred
and ninety, personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk
of the Superior Court a COURT OF RECORD within and for the county and

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Chas. H.
Louis who was ENROLLED as a Private on the 13th
day of Sept. 1866, in Company F. of the 7th Regiment of
Md. Vols. commanded by Indianola, Tex.
and was honorably DISCHARGED at Indianola, Tex. on the 13
day of Oct. 1866; that his personal description is as follows: age 43
years; height 5 feet 7 inches; complexion black; hair black
eyes black. That while a member of the organization aforesaid in the service and in
the line of duty, at Jacksonville, in the State of Fla.
on or about the 13th day of Oct., 1864, he contracted
Disease of Right Eye.
