

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

This Must be Executed Before a Court of Record or Some Officer Thereof Having Custody of its Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 7th day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me, a Notary Public of the Court, a Court

of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Sidney (Hind) Windner,

aged 50 years, a resident of the City of Baltimore,

County of Baltimore, State of Md., who, being

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Sidney Windner,

who was ENROLLED on the 1st day of August, 1868, in

Co. A, 19 U.S.C.T., (Here state rank, company and

regiment, in Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.)

in the war of the rebellion, and served at least

ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, on the

day of August, 1869. That he is partially unable to earn a support by

reason of rupture of left side, in service, and

dimmed eyes.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That

he has never applied for pension under application No. That he is a pensioner

under Certificate No. (If a pensioner, the Certificate only need be given. If not, give the number of the former

application if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

A. Pearce Lloyd of Baltimore, Md., his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, he paid a fee of ten dollars,
