While serving in Co. 30 Reg't U.S.C.V. he was disabled by malarial fever, chronic diarrhoea, affection of kidneys at Petersburg, Va., 1865.

also sprained right wrist, resulting erysipelas at St. Fisher N.C.

and was treated in hospitals of which the names, location, and dates of treatment are as follows:
