Madam:

After due consideration of all testimony on file in your claim, original number 617,413, under the Act of April 19, 1908, you are advised that this Bureau declines to reopen for further prosecution your said claim, rejected December 21, 1912 on the ground that you were not the legal widow of the soldier, for the reason that the testimony filed fails to overcome the former evidence which showed conclusively that at the time of your attempted marriage to the soldier he had a living wife from whom he was never divorced and who survived him. There is no law under which further pension benefits can be conferred upon you.
