DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

State of MARYLAND, County of BALTIMORE ss:

On this 6th day of November, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and twelve personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and state aforesaid May G. Jobes aged 54 years, a resident of Baltimore City, County of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the Act of Congress Approved, April 19, 1908.

That she is the widow of Jeremiah Jobes, who was enrolled (Enrolled or commissioned) under the name of Jeremiah Jobes, at Fortress Monroe, Va., on the day of , 18 as a Private in Co. K. 30th Maryland Regt Here state rank, and company and regiment, in the Army, or vessels, if in the Navy. U. S. C. V. and honorably discharged , 18 , having served ninety days or more during the late civil war.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services if any.)

That he was not in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above

That she was married under the name of May G. Martin to said soldier at Baltimore Md. on the 1st day of May, 18 77 by Rev. Lantz at Ebenezer Church; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage that she had not been previously married; that the soldier had not been previously married

(If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated.)

and that neither she nor said soldier married otherwise than is stated above.

That the said soldier died March 9th, 18 95, at Baltimore, Md. that she was not divorced from him, and that she has not remarried since his death.

That the said soldier left the following-named children who are now living and under sixteen years of age, to wit: (If the soldier left no children, the claimant should so state.)

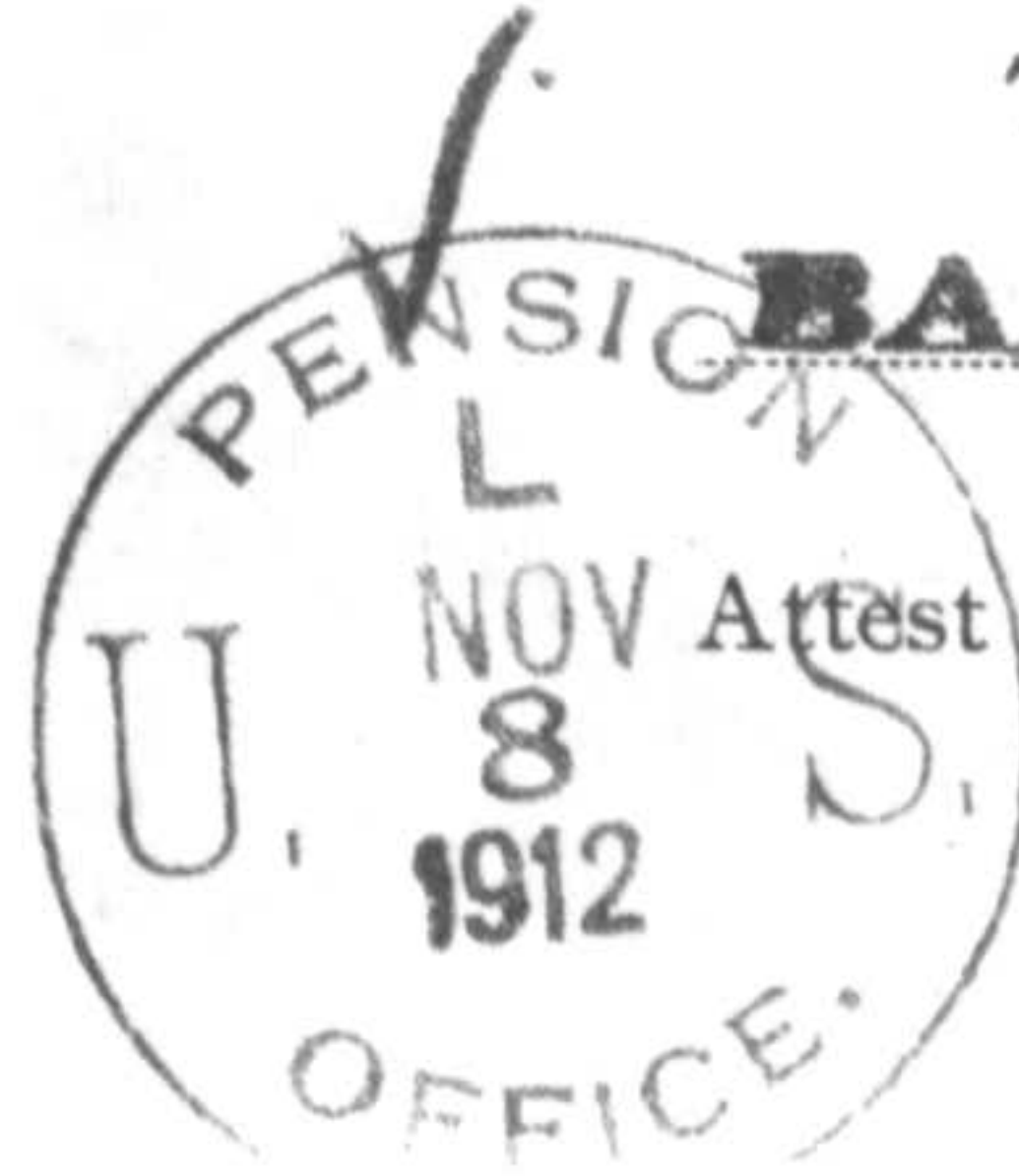
That she has heretofore applied for pension (If prior application has been made, the number thereof, the service on which it was based, and the name of the soldier should be stated.)
