Dear sir Jeremiah Jobs, Faulkner in the
 Civil War he married me after
 he came back from Civil War 1877
 we live together after we married until
 he died he died 1895 March 9th
 I buried him myself and haven't
 received any funeral expenses from the
 war or any money since he has been dead
 I have been from hand to Mouth every
 since my husband been dead he said
 before he died Mary this money left from
 the war is left to take care of you
 until you die he said even if you
 live to get older and helpless for to care
 of you when you can't help your self
 and I haven't received any money as
 yet he was in the 30th Maryland
 Regiment he told me when he went
 away from Baltimore here he did not
 listed for the Battle field until he got
 to Road-oak Island the 30th Maryland
 Regiment Company D. nearest I can
 remember he listed under Cap.
 Safford he received
