 after I went there I began to live  
 with him in the relation of wife  
 and so lived with him until  
 1876 the year of the Centennial at Phila.  
 the July of that year. I was never  
~~was~~ married to said Samuel Shelton  
 No form of ceremony was ever said  
 over us - I was never married  
 to any man except Jeremiah  
 Jobs - I have never lived in the  
 relation of wife with any man  
 other than Jobs and Samuel Shelton.  
 I was never divorced from Jeremiah  
 Jobs and he was never divorced  
 from me - Neither Jeremiah Jobs or my-  
 self were ever married before we  
 married each other. Since I came  
 back from New Orleans I have lived most  
 here and in Phila. Pa but never with  
 any man - I have since 1876 worked and  
 supported myself. I have never made any  
 claim for pension. My answers are  
 correctly recorded herein.
