 for the pension of *Jeremiah Jones*
 which had accrued at the date
 of his death.

I am the widow of *Jeremiah Jones*
 who served during the Civil War
 in Co. H. 30th Inf.

I was married to said *Jeremiah Jones*
May 16, 1847 here in *Baltimore Md.* with regular license and ceremony
 by *Rev. Mr. Landsey*.

I was never married before
 I married said *Jeremiah Jones*.
 He was married before he
 married me as he said to
 a woman named *Mary* before the
 war. He never lived with her
 after the war she left him and
 went to *New Orleans* and married
 again. *Jeremiah* said he got a
 divorce from said woman before
 he married me. I don't know
 when he got it but he said he got
 it here in *Baltimore*. His first
 wife is now called *Mary Shelton*
