Madam:

Relative to your claim for reimbursement in the case of Sophia Queen, Wid. Ctf. #324,216, you are advised that a statement is required over the signature of Dr. Robinson, showing by whom the payment of \$8 was made on his bill December 20, 1914, and that he holds you responsible for the balance due thereon.

You should also furnish a statement showing the name of the fraternal order by which the bill of the undertaker was paid.

A statement is required over the signature of Lena Franklin, showing the amount of the pensioner's life insurance money, used by her in payment of expenses of pensioner's last sickness and burial.

This evidence was called for in the Bureau letter addressed to you under date of April 5, 1915, and your claim cannot be given further consideration until you shall have complied with these necessary requirements.
