I was the bridesmaid of Sophia Queen formerly when she was married to Isaac Queen 18th July 1857. The ceremony was performed by Rev Mr Brown pastor of Wesley Chappel. Neither of the contracting parties had been married prior to their intermarriage. Both were then quite young. She has not remarried since his death. The date of her marriage I know to be correct from comparing it with other events. Neither were slaves.

And she has no interest in the claim of Sophia Queen for Pension
