That she was married under the name of Sophia, to said Thomas Queen, on the day of 18, by, at

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Thomas Queen (Name of soldier or sailor.)

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor. That names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows: Florence, born 18 May, 1874; Lebo, born June 1, 1881; Seward, born Mar 9, 1878; Moses Samuel, born 18, totally blind & helpless, 18.

That she has heretofore applied for a pension and the number of her former application is 417141. That she makes this

declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890. She hereby appoints

A. Parlett Lloyd of Baltimore Md her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, and agrees to pay her said attorney a fee of Ten Dollars upon the allowance of the claim. That her post-office address is
